Busoga premier urges bodaboda riders on education

The prime minister of Busoga Kingdom, Dr Joseph Muvawala, has urged bodaboda motorcyclists to educate their children in order to fight poverty.

He said the people of Busoga have a poor attitude toward education.

"With education, one is in a better position to get work and think beyond the box to fight poverty," Muvawala said.

He made the remarks during the

swearing-in ceremony of Simon Musoby, the chairperson of the Jinja Municipal Council Bodaboda Association, and his committee.

The function was conducted by Jinja Grade One Magistrate Peter Mutala at Kakindu Stadium in Jinja town.

Others who took oath were the three municipal division chairpersons.

Muvawala also urged the motorcyclists to be faithful in their marriages as well as invest in land, instead of leasing it for sugarcane growing.
