

# Luweero gets Shs12b water treatment plant

**LUWEERO.** National Water and Sewerage Corporation (NWSC) has completed construction of a Shs12b water treatment plant to serve Luweero Triangle.

Speaking during the inspection of the completed works yesterday, Mr Ronald Kisakye, the area manager, said the new plant will serve the towns of Semuto, Nakaseke, Ngoma, Bukomero and Kiboga.

"We have 250 new water connections and a population of more than 750,000. Our service area of Luweero Triangle stretches from Kiboga to Nakasongola," he told journalists.

Mr Chris Ebal, the NWSC board chairman, said the project is designed to serve Singo Military Barracks, factories in the industrial park and they have plans to make it a green facility using solar panels.

"We are going to install solar panels to make it cost effective. Our pumps are already energy efficient and we want to make them cost effective. We are putting boreholes to handle towns which are water stressed," he said.

He also said the company plans to pump water from Karuma Falls to supply all towns on the Kampala-Gulu highway.
