



## Rains destroy sorghum

Beer companies may suffer a setback in procuring sorghum for its Kisumu plant following heavy rains and voracious appetite by birds conspiring to destroy the crop still on farms. More than 12,000 growers in Nyando, West Karachuonyo and Lambwe Valley in Kisumu and Homa Bay counties have been hit by the torrents and ravenous birds. Chairperson of Homa Bay County sorghum farmers Ager Kiroho expressed fear the two may slash their harvests. "Floods have destroyed our sorghum farms," says Kiroho.

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
