Bishop promotes fish farming

Arua diocese has turned to promoting fish farming in an effort to put an end to malnutrition in families.

Owing to the fact several families cannot afford to eat balanced diet food especially containing protein, the diocese through Caritas has started training 45 youths in aquaculture especially fish farming in Arivu Sub-county for the next four years.

During the commissioning of the project, the Bishop of Arua diocese, Rt Rev Sabino Ocan Odoki, said: "It is sad that many families cannot feed well and their children lack protein. So we need to promote fish farming. And 40 per cent of children here do not get protein and this affects the brain of the children."

The youths have already started establishing fish ponds in the communities in order to multiply the fish and do business.
