

# Health workers cry for help

**MITYANA.** Health workers at Kasikombe Health Centre II have appealed to Mityana District officials to renovate some of the staff buildings at the facility that were destroyed by a storm recently. According to Mr Emmanuel Tumusiime, the officer-in-charge of the health facility, part of the staff quarters' roof was blown off by the storm on December 26. "We are currently challenged by lack of accommodation for our staff and have reached an extent of sharing the only room which was spared by the storm," Mr Tumusiime said. Dr Fred Lwasampija, the district health officer, said they were aware of the problem and assigned an engineer to survey the affected buildings.
