Rebuttal

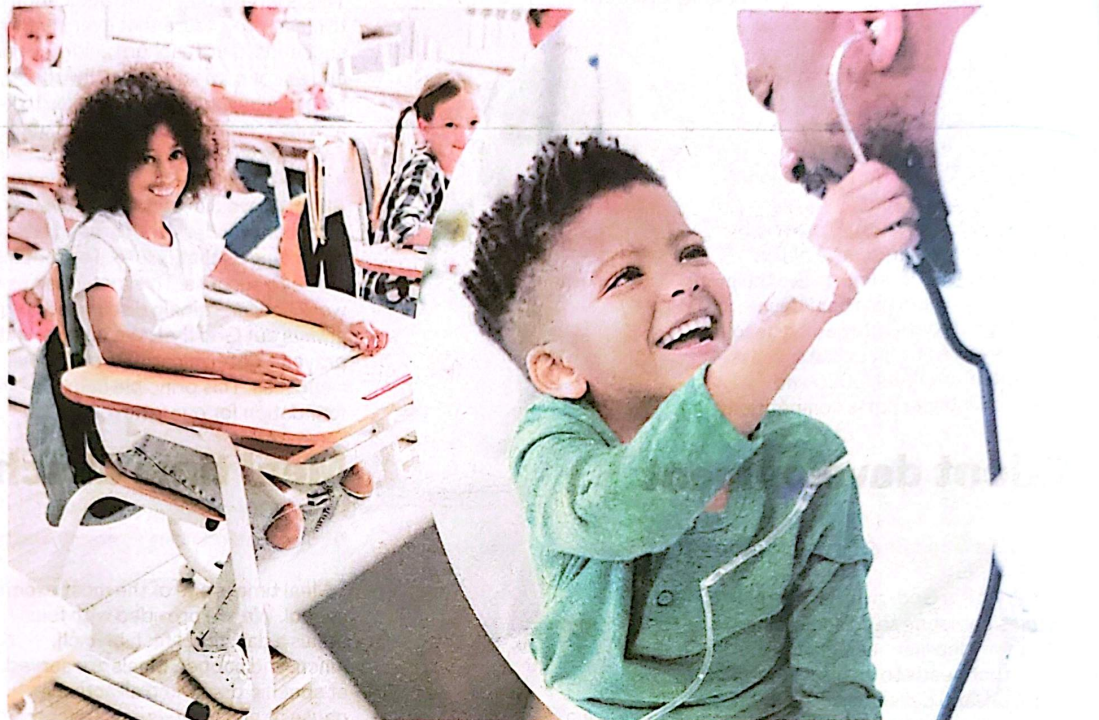
I would like to disagree with my friends who say medical care is better than education.
