

Uncollected rubbish angers councillors

A group of Kaberamaido town councillors demonstrated over poor garbage collection in the area on Monday.

To illustrate their displeasure, the councillors wheeled a heap of garbage and dumped it inside the building that houses the town's administration offices.

David Oswald Einyu, one of the councillors, said garbage had not been collected for three months.

In an emergency meeting attended by the deputy chief administrative office, Richard Madeta, the councillors accused the town clerk of failing to implement what they had agreed on in previous meetings.

Peter Erisu, the town clerk, did not attend the meeting.

Stephen Erau, who represented the town clerk's office, said they lacked funds and transport to collect the garbage.

Meanwhile, Einyu said the poor service delivery in Kaberamaido town council is due to lack of co-operation between the technical arm and the political wing.

Madeta said the demonstration by the councillors was uncalled for.
