**Pupils adapt food
campaign**

KASESE: The government under the Ministry of Education in 2014 launched a project code named 'Uganda Multi-sectoral Food Security and Nutrition project' that is being piloted in 100 primary schools in Kasese District. According to the Kasese District education officer, George Mayinja, the pilot study follows the survey that indicated high malnutrition and stunted growth levels that are believed to be causing poor academic performance in schools.

"We identified 100 schools that are implementing the food security and nutrition project supported by the World Bank as one way of improving the feeding habits among the communities," Mayinja says.

Jovaline Biira, 12, a Primary Four pupil at Kasanga Primary School in Bwera Sub-county Kasese district is among the children who have quickly adapted to the project ideology to cause a change at her home.

Biira who owns a food garden at her home in Mitimushanju village in Bwera says she was encouraged to grow vegetables by her teachers.
