

Ex-Monitor editor wins Dokolo North

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DOKOLO. Mr Paul Amoru Omiat has joined Parliament on second attempt. Mr Amoru, who previously worked with *Daily Monitor* as an editor, was declared winner of the Dokolo North parliamentary seat by Dokolo District returning officer, Mr Benjamin Ewal. Mr Amoru, who was run-

ning on the NRM ticket, polled 15,442 votes, while his rival and FDC flag bearer John Baptist Okello Okello got 14,978 votes. Mr Okello has been the Dokolo District chairman for the last 10 years. Mr Amoru first attempted to become MP in 2011 on the FDC ticket but lost to NRM's Felix Okot Ogong. This is before Dokolo County was split into north and south.
