

Bitangaro back as MP

KISORO. Former state minister for Gender, Labour and Social Development Sam Bitangaro (NRM) has bounced back as MP for Bufumbira South in Kisoro District, polling 31,794 votes. He defeated

Ms Lillian Mbabazi (Independent), who got 5,270 votes and Vincent Mushakamba (FDC), who received 600 votes.

Mr Bitangaro lost his seat to Mr Tress Buchanayandi in 2006 and had since been out of politics. "My success was because of the development projects I started in the con-

stituency when I was the area MP. I am ready to serve every one regardless of whether they voted for me or not," Mr Bitangaro said. He promised to lobby government for projects such as piped water and good roads, among others.



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
