Farmers have been urged to embrace the concept of one stop centre concept in order to empower them to establish sustainable value chains for the selected enterprises within rural communities.

"The approach was initiated to build the capacity of farmers to access services from various sources public and private. It is a tool aimed at sustaining the services of any programme (SG2000) within a community beyond its period and improving farmers' access to markets and increase household income," said Dr Roselline Nyamutale, the country director Sasakawa Global 2000.
