# Kisoro Church constructs school for vulnerable children

A total of 36 vulnerable children in Rubuguri town council, Kisoro district have a reason to smile. It follows the commissioning of Hope Missionary Primary School, which will offer them free primary education.

The school was constructed by Hope for Uganda Ministries, a church-based non-governmental organisation attached to Lift Up Church in Rubuguri sub-county, Kisoro district.

Commissioning the school recently, Emmanuel Mwumvaneza, the Kisoro district inspector of schools, asked the school management to co-operate with the district education authorities to ensure that the teaching follows the national curriculum.

Mwumvaneza asked the mission to also consider the establishment of a technical school in the area so as to help children fight unemployment.

"We see a lot of schools starting up in Uganda every time, but we prefer developers starting them according

to expectations of the education ministry. We shall be doing regular visits here to see if that is followed," he said.

Manasseh Rukundo, the Kisoro district deputy chief administrative officer, hailed the founders for the school.

"The Government cannot reach everywhere to avail services to its people, so when such initiatives come on board, we welcome them because they are another source of hope for our people," Rukundo said.
