

Masaka Khadi backs Museveni stay in power

MASAKA. Masaka District Kadhi has backed the controversial Bill that seeks to amend Article 102(b) of the Constitution to remove the presidential age limit.

Sheikh Bruhan Bagunduse, who subscribes to the Old Kampala faction, argued that President Museveni has done a good job and must be given the opportunity to accomplish his goals.

Article 102 (b) currently bars any citizen aged below 35 or above 75 years from vying for presidency.

Addressing NRM supporters in Masaka Town at the weekend, Sheikh Bagunduse said it was only fair for Ugandans to allow President Museveni to continue with his legacy "since he has served the country diligently".

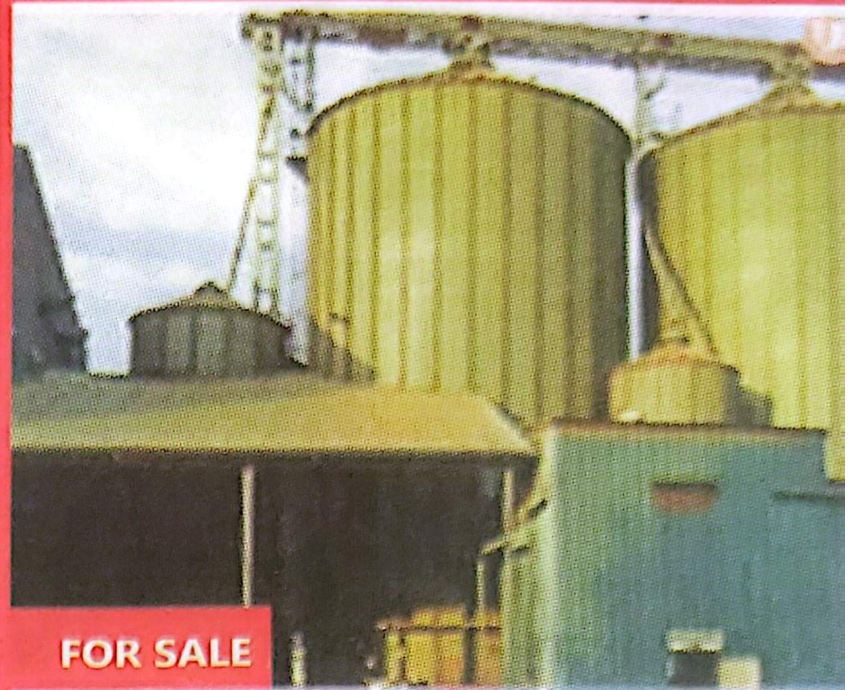
"God has bestowed peace unto our country through him. What then stops us from supporting our President?" he asked.

Sheikh Bagunduse warned Ugandans against listening to what he called 'self-seekers' likening the current government to that of the past regimes.

He condemned those blocking clerics from commenting on political matters, saying they should be given chance to guide their followers.
