

# School dropout jailed for forged academic paper

**KAMPALA.** A Senior Three school dropout has been sentenced to 18 months in jail for securing a job in the Judiciary on a forged academic certificate. Paul Tusubira Musisi was a process server in the judiciary from July 2003 to November 2017 when he was interdicted.

“The convict denied another qualified Ugandan an opportunity to be employed. Musisi, you caused this country a loss, as you offered substandard services. You are hereby sentenced to 18 months in prison. You have a right to appeal if you are dissatisfied with the court decision,” ruled Magistrate Gladys Kamasanyu at Buganda Road Chief Magistrate’s Court yesterday, adding: “...evidence from prosecution witnesses proved that you are the one who forged the document, since you gave in to sit for an interview for a job where you had no qualification. The ingredient of uttering a forged result slip was as proved...”

The convict presented a forged Uganda Certificate of Education (UCE) slip which he provided for his application for the job.
