

Kyalya concedes, alerts Museveni for job

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JINJA. Independent presidential candidate Maureen Kyalya has conceded defeat, congratulating Mr Yoweri Museveni upon his victory in last Thursday's presidential elections.

Ms Kyalya who polled 0.44 per cent of the vote was, however, quick to point out that there had been anomalies such as intimidation and voter bribery, but because her message had been one of peace, unity and cooperation, she was putting the concerns aside in the interest of Uganda.

"Surely, the ground was unlevelled but as a mother who loves peace and unity and one who understands that I am smaller than Uganda, I am abiding by the majority decision," she said.

Ms Kyalya, who was also the only female candidate in the race for presidency, expressed willingness to work with President Museveni if an opportunity arises.
