Gulu emerge supreme in Clinical School championship

Gulu School of Clinical School (SOCO) emerged top overall in this year's 15th edition of national inter-Schools of Clinical Officers Games.

The hosts collected a total of five gold medals after beating the field of 60 teams to win in athletics, volleyball, basketball, handball and rugby to go

unassailable among the 60 teams that took part in the event.

The Old Mulago-based University Institute of Applied Management Sciences (UIAMS) came second with three Gold medals.

Meanwhile, another Gulu-based team, Lacor School of Nursing took the athletics title, winning Gold, UIAMS (Silver medal) and Jinja Nursing School won the Bronze medal in the

same event.

In the Soccer games, Jerusalem Schools of Nursing from Lira district was the overall winner taking the Gold medal position, Jinja Medical Laboratory team won second place with Silver medal and Arua Nursing School took the Bronze in 3rd place.

Despite outstanding performances in the athletics at Pece War Memorial stadium, Lira Nursing Team was disqualified

from the championship for fielding non-bonafide students, which the organizers said contravened the competitions national rules and regulations.

Lira was consequently banned for three years and are expected to return to championship in 2021.

The committee discovered that some of the mercenaries in the Lira team were picked from secondary schools in the area.
