

6 people killed in Teso during Christmas season

SOROTI. At least six people have so far been confirmed dead in Teso sub-region during the festive season, according to police.

Addressing journalists on Tuesday, East Kyoga regional police commander Francis Tumwesigye said three people died in a fatal accident when a vehicle registration number UAP 594W Land Cruiser they were traveling in overturned at Acilo Trading Centre along Soroti- Serere road on Monday around 9pm. The driver is suspected to have been driving at high speed.

Children killed

Mr Tumwesigye identified the deceased persons as juveniles from one family that included Desire Kobusinge 12, Brenda Aluka 8, and another only identified as Asante. "Their father, Mr John Ojur, who was driving the vehicle lost control and overturned" Mr Tumwesigye said.

Speaking to *Daily Monitor*, at his hospital bed today, Mr Ojur said an ambulance drove past them leaving behind dust that covered their car.
