# Butambala emerges shock top district in A-Level results

**Butambala top.** At least 545 of the 1,220 students in the district got three principal passes.

**KAMPALA.** The Uganda Advanced Certificate of Education (UACE) examinations results released on Friday saw Butambala emerge out of the shadows to beat 111 districts in the country as the best performing district. A total of 1,220 students sat

for exams last year in the Central region district and 545 managed to get at least three principal passes, representing 45.3 per cent. The best schools in the district, Budinse Memorial School, although ranks in the 205th position in the list of the best schools rankings, had 59 per cent of students passing with the average points of 11 out of 20.

Butambala was closely followed by districts including Mukono, Wakiso and Kampala.

A total of 2,845 students recorded

three principal passes in Mukono, representing a 44 per cent success rate, while Wakiso registered 7,316 students with three principal passes.

However, Wakiso's St Mary's Secondary School, Kitende, outshined all schools in the country with 78 per cent of its students scoring average points of 15 out of 20. This was followed by Uganda Martyrs Namugongo with 71 per cent; Kings College Budo with 69 per cent; Seeta High School, Naalya S.S Bweyogerere, Gayaza High School, among

others.

The districts of Hoima and Bushenyi rounded up the fourth and fifth best districts, respectively.

On the other hand, Dokolo, Adjumani and Nakapiripirit districts rounded up at the bottom of the worst performing districts. Nakapiripirit, for example, did not record any student with three principle passes, while Adjumani and Dokolo, respectively registered two students only.

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
