

## Korea boost potato growers

**MASINDI:** The Korean Programme on International Agriculture (KOPIA) Uganda Centre in partnership with Naro has launched a three-year project on increasing potato productivity and farmers' income through the supply of quality seed potatoes. The project will be implemented at Kachwekano and Rwebitaba Zonal Agriculture Research institutes in Rubanda and Kabarole districts. The director KOPIA Uganda centre, Dr Shim Hongsik, and the director Kachwekano Zonal Agriculture Research Institute, Dr Alex Barekye, on Friday signed a memorandum of understanding that detailed the work methods for each stakeholder. Dr Hongsik said the three-year project is worth \$120,000 (Shs450m) and is funded by Korean government.
