YUMBE. Lightning has killed a mother and her three daughters in village four, block 4, zone II in Bidi-Bidi Refugee Settlement in Yumbe District.

Mr Solomon Osakan, Arua refugee desk officer, under the Office of the Prime Minister, identified the deceased as Jennifer Dusman, a 26-year-old South Sudanese refugee and her three children Mary Kadi, 6, Reinda Jokudu, 5 and Scovia Yeno, 4.

Mr Musoke Abubakar, the Yumbe

District police commander confirmed the Sunday incident, which occurred at about 2am during a heavy down pour.

"Police visited the scene and the bodies were taken to Yumbe Hospital for postmortem," Mr Musoke said.

Mr Kenneth Remo, a neighbour said: "We rushed to the scene only to find the house burning. We tried to rescue them but all our efforts were
