The provision of basic quality education is well entrenched in the Constitution where it is indicated that all children in Uganda are entitled to quality education.

Goal 6 on the framework of Educational Forum on Education for All calls for 'Improving every aspect of the quality of education and ensuring... excellence so that recognised and measurable learning outcomes are achieved by all, especially in literacy, numeracy and essential life skills.' But where do we fall

as a country?

There is no single definition, list of criteria, definitive curriculum, or list of topics that comprise a quality education. In spite of definitional difficulties, Unesco (2004, p. 17), has identified two basic principles underlying quality education: First, it identifies learners' cognitive development as the major explicit objective of all education systems.

Accordingly, the success with which systems achieve this is one indicator of their quality. The second emphasises

education's role in promoting values and attitudes of citizenship and nurturing creative and emotional development. Because quality education must be locally relevant and culturally appropriate

In North America and Europe, the term quality education has many interpretations and is sometimes synonymous with school perfection or school effectiveness. What is quality of education in Uganda?
