

Farmers to benefit from Shs900m grant

Lutheran World Relief (LWR) has initiated a partnership with Bukonzo organic farmers' cooperative union to fund agricultural projects in the region supporting Arabica coffee farming.

While launching the fund last Friday in Kinyamaseke, Kasese District, Kenneth Barigya, the Lutheran country director urged farmers to grow more Arabica coffee and improve their livelihoods.

Barigya also emphasised that 3000 beneficiary farmers, 1000 should be women.

The grant worth Shs900m was received on behalf of the farmers by Josita Kabugho the managing director Bukonzo organic farmer's cooperatives.
